Safety



Clouds, sunglasses, photo-film are not safe to use for viewing an eclipse

Never look at the Partial Eclipse without proper certified filter. Solar eyeglasses are meant for brief viewing 3-5 seconds every 10 minutes or so.

Photo tips

Don't sacrifice viewing the eclipse to get the perfect picture

Buy solar filters early and test before eclipse day

Where / When

The closer you are to the centre of the shadow path, the longer will be the totality. Outside the path of totality will be a partial eclipse of varying amounts.

Eclipse will be late in the afternoon and the Sun will be low in the sky.

The next NL Total Solar Eclipse after 2024 will be May 01, 2079

Preparations

Prepare for cold weather. May need to drive on the day of the eclipse.

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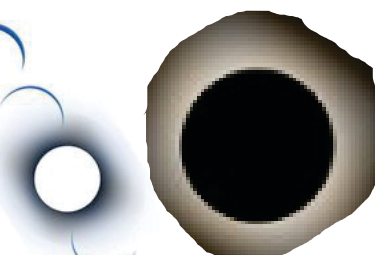
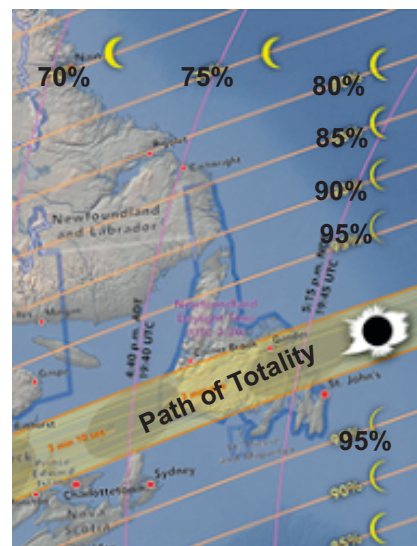
